



## **CITY-WIDE RESIDENTIAL PARKING ONLY PROGRAM**

Chapter 28-121.12

### **ELIGIBILITY**

A person is eligible for a Residential Parking Only permit if the person:

1. Owns or occupies a residence or business establishment located within the resident-parking-only zone;
2. Has no unresolved parking citations issued by the City;
3. Has no outstanding fines or warrants for a violation of this division.

### **COST OF PERMIT**

The cost of an annual permit is \$6.00 + Tax = **\$6.50** each permit

(Each residence or business located within a zone may apply for up to six permits.)

### **REQUIREMENTS**

To prove that an applicant owns or occupies a residence or business establishment located within a resident-parking-only zone and to verify the contents of the application, the applicant must present, at the time of the application, the following documents:

1. A valid Texas driver's license, military identification card, passport, or personal identification card issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety, showing the applicant's current home address; and
2. A recent utility bill, that is addressed to the applicant and shows an address of a residence or business establishment located within the resident-parking-only zone.
